From the home page, just click on the link for geocities. On-line help is available if you need assistance.
14. **Games.** If you can't seem to find the perfect toy at the pet store, why not make your own. Take an old sock, stuff it with cotton and secure it with heavy string. Then draw a face on the sock using a non-toxic marker from a craft store. Your dog will love you for it. Another inexpensive thing to buy is a Frisbee. not buy them a talking rose that says “I love you” from www.charmingpetproducts.com How sweet is that? They also sell rubber chickens, party hats, charms and various other great toys.
